Application Deadline POSTMARKED by March 6: Mail Application, Application/jury fee of \$20 (nonrefundable) and BOOTH FEE: \$165 per booth (10' X 10'), or \$330 for a double booth (10' x 20'). Booth fee check or money order is returned if not accepted in your provided self-addressed, stamped envelope. SEE LATE FEES (March 7-20) on page 2.

<u>Prior participation is not a guarantee of acceptance for 2026.</u> Previously selected participants may request a location and will be granted <u>when possible</u>.

ELECTRICITY available in <u>limited booth areas</u>: \$20 additional fee (separate check). NO Generators.

All pieces must be original and handcrafted by the Artist - See categories listed on page 2. All pieces should be of excellent quality and design. Prints are acceptable from artist's original work only. Resale items, buy/sell imports, or commercially produced products are NOT ALLOWED. Products that appear to be mass produced would not be allowed. The Festival Committee reserves the right to require removal of items that do not meet these guidelines or are deemed inappropriate for family viewing. We will limit the number of entries in each category in order to maintain a good "mix" of artwork. Accepted artists will be featured on the Festival's Facebook Page to promote sales and attendance. Therefore, ipeg images are required for jurying AND posting artwork. Please do not send printed photos.

Artists are responsible for staffing their own booth during entire festival hours (no representatives) and for collecting and paying Georgia sales tax (8% for Lumpkin County).

<u>Check-in/Set-up</u>: <u>Details will be emailed to accepted artists.</u> Check in at Festival Information Booth in front of Visitors Center (<u>13 S. Park St</u>) Friday, May 15 or Saturday morning.

<u>Booths</u>: Artists must provide their own set-ups, chairs, tables, and <u>white, cream or tan canopy top</u>. The exhibit space is located on asphalt. <u>Canopies must be secured with weights (25 lbs/leg min)</u>. We provide space between booths for viewing and visitor access, <u>but not as an additional display area</u>.

<u>Sharing a Booth</u>: <u>Two artists</u> may share a booth. <u>Each artist must submit an application, application/jury</u> fee, and jpg images of his/her work. Only one booth fee is needed.

<u>Images of artwork</u> must represent the work that you have created over the past 5 years and is representative of the work that you will exhibit and sell. <u>Email 6 or more images(jpgs) of artwork</u>, includes one of your <u>booth display</u> to <u>chestatee.artists@gmail.com</u>. Mailing application/jury fee, send to <u>Chestatee Artists</u>, <u>P O Box 572</u>, <u>Dahlonega</u>, <u>GA 30533</u>. Keep in mind that images/jpegs from accepted artists will be posted on our *Dahlonega Arts & Wine Festival* Facebook page for <u>promotional purposes</u>.
